## 12天10晚 交叉路口历史上的高加索

### 阿塞拜疆 + 格鲁吉亚 + 亚美尼亚

#### 第一天 吉隆坡 - 阿塞拜疆

机上用餐

集合于国际机场，乘搭客机飞往阿塞拜疆的首都 - 巴库。

#### 第二天 巴库

午晚餐

巴库旧城之旅，我们将从高地公园开始，俯瞰巴库湾的全景，欣赏里海的壮丽景色。接下来，我们将探索巴库历史的中心 - 被联合国教科文组织列为世界遗产的古城**伊切里谢赫** - 这里过去与现在交织在一起。我们将参观**谢尔万沙赫宫** - 曾是谢尔万沙赫王朝的皇家住所。**处女塔** - 是巴库最神秘的古迹，传说与琐罗亚斯德教仪式和丝绸之路商人有关。**驿站** - 曾是丝绸之路商旅的休息站，现在是一个充满魅力的庭院。我们还将漫步在狭窄的鹅卵石街道上，感受独特的古老风情。**聚马清真寺** - 位于古城内，至今仍有人居住，古城内超过 1300 个家庭生活在这里，形成了一个“城中之城”。

#### 第三天 巴库 - 戈布斯坦 - 泥火山 (80 公里, 约 2 小时 30 分钟) - 阿布谢隆半岛

(55 公里, 约 1 小时 30 分钟) - 巴库 (13 公里, 约 30 分钟)

早午晚餐

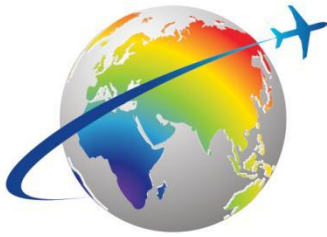
**戈布斯坦之旅** (联合国教科文组织世界遗产) - 是一个拥有超过 6000 幅古老岩刻的历史遗址，描绘了史前时期的狩猎场景、宗教仪式和动物。这些岩刻展示了阿塞拜疆古代文化的丰富遗产，是探索人类早期文明的重要地点。**阿塞拜疆著名的泥火山** - 有世界近一半的泥火山，这些泥火山富含矿物质，被广泛用于治疗和美容。游客可以欣赏到独特的自然景观，并了解泥火山的独特地质和治疗作用。**下午参观阿布谢隆半岛：火焰神庙** - 这座五边形建筑群是琐罗亚斯德教的圣地，是信徒的朝圣地点。中央有一个露天庭院和神庙祭坛，曾是信徒们进行仪式和祈祷的地方。

**焰山** - 燃烧的山，这座天然气火焰山已经在山坡上燃烧了数百年，展现了阿塞拜疆“火之国”的独特景观，给人留下深刻印象。

#### 第四天 巴库 - 谢基 - 丝绸之路小镇 (15 公里, 约 30 分钟) - 巴库

早午晚餐

驱车前往谢基，途中欣赏壮丽的山景。探索谢基丰富的历史遗产。**谢基汗宫 (1797 年)** - 夏宫，建于 1797 年，由穆罕默德·哈桑·汗建造。宫殿以其精美的彩色玻璃窗而闻名，内部装饰有精致的瓷砖、喷泉和多处彩色玻璃窗。宫殿原本是谢基汗堡垒内更大建筑群的一部分，包含了冬宫、汗的家族住所和仆人宿舍。如今，夏宫是唯一保留的结构。宫殿外部装饰有深蓝色、绿松石色和赭石色的几何图案瓷砖，墙壁上的壁画则采用温暖的蛋彩画，灵感来自波斯诗人尼扎米·甘贾维的作品。**谢基驿站** - 这是一个古老的丝绸之路贸易站，曾是商旅的休息之地，承载着丝绸之路的历史和文化。在这里，您可以感受到过去商人们在此停留和交流的氛围。



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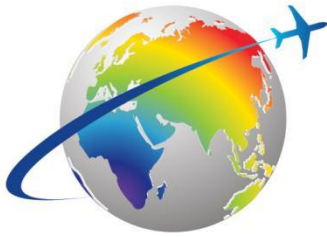
## 第五天 阿塞拜疆 - 锡纳吉 (112 公里, 约 2 小时) - 博德贝修道院 (46 公里, 约 1 小时) - 第比利斯 (110 公里, 约 2 小时) 早午晚餐

我们将通过拉戈德基边境, 进入格鲁吉亚, 开始我们的探索之旅。在这里, 我们会与当地导游会合, 参观**锡纳吉** - 浪漫的“爱情之城”。位于海拔 790 米的山顶, 俯瞰着阿拉扎尼谷地的全景。城市以其鹅卵石街道、柔和的色彩房屋和传统的木制阳台而著称, 展现了无与伦比的古朴之美和浪漫氛围。锡纳吉还拥有一座保存完好的 18 世纪防御墙, 常被称为“格鲁吉亚长城”, 从这里可以欣赏到阿拉扎尼谷地和高加索雪山的壮丽景色。街道两旁是五彩斑斓的木质阳台、温馨的咖啡馆和手工艺品商店, 感受这个古镇的独特魅力。**博德贝修道院圣尼诺的圣地** - 是格鲁吉亚最重要的朝圣地之一。这里是格鲁吉亚基督教化的重要人物——圣尼诺的安息之地。修道院建于 9 世纪, 最受尊敬的朝圣地点。我们将参观圣尼诺的泉水, 据说具有疗愈的功效, 许多朝圣者前来此地祈求祝福和精神上的复兴。**葡萄酒文化体验** - 金兹马鲁利公司品酒卡赫季地区以其悠久的葡萄酒酿造历史闻名。我们将参观金兹马鲁利公司, 体验格鲁吉亚传奇的葡萄酒文化, 品尝当地酿制的美味葡萄酒, 了解葡萄酒的酿造工艺和历史传统。

## 第六天 第比利斯市区游 - 东西方的融合 早午晚餐

**第比利斯** - 是格鲁吉亚的首都, 这里融合了古老的历史和现代的活力, 是东西方文化交汇的地方。**梅特基教堂与瓦赫唐·戈尔吉萨利国王雕像** - 梅特基教堂位于悬崖上, 俯瞰着姆特克瓦里河, 是第比利斯最早有人居住的地方之一。教堂和国王瓦赫唐·戈尔吉萨利的雕像象征着第比利斯的历史起源和王朝的辉煌。**纳里卡拉堡垒** - 乘坐缆车从里克公园。前往这座历史悠久的堡垒, 堡垒自 4 世纪以来一直守护着第比利斯。从堡垒顶部, 您可以俯瞰到第比利斯市区和周围的美丽风景。**硫磺浴区** - 漫步在这个标志性的区, 欣赏自然热硫磺温泉的景观。这里的硫磺浴已有几个世纪的历史, 曾是格鲁吉亚传统的休闲和治疗中心。**锡奥尼大教堂** - 这座历史悠久的格鲁吉亚东正教大教堂以耶路撒冷的锡安山命名。曾经, 这里保存着圣尼诺的十字架, 这是一件格鲁吉亚基督教遗产中的神圣遗物。**沙尔登街** - 这是第比利斯一条迷人的现代街道, 街道两旁布满了温馨的咖啡馆、艺术画廊和精品店, 是体验现代城市风貌的好地方。**和平桥** - 这座由意大利建筑师米凯莱·德·卢基设计的玻璃与钢铁结构的行人桥, 连接了第比利斯的历史老城区与现代化的街区。它是一座标志性的现代建筑。**圣三一大教堂** - 是世界上最大的东正教教堂之一, 于 2004 年完工, 作为格鲁吉亚东正教信仰的精神中心, 是该国最重要的宗教建筑之一。**鲁斯塔维利大道** - 驱车沿着第比利斯的主干道鲁斯塔维利大道行驶, 这里是格鲁吉亚议会、歌剧院和自由广场的所在地。沿途您可以欣赏到这条街道上的宏伟建筑和现代景观。





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## 第七天 第比利斯 - 阿纳努里 (65 公里 1 小时 30 分钟) - 津瓦利水库 (9 公里 15 分钟) - 古达乌里 (65 公里 1 小时 30 分钟) - 卡兹别吉- 格尔盖蒂教堂 (38 公里 1 小时) - 第比利斯 早午晚餐

沿着历史悠久的格鲁吉亚军事公路，穿越大高加索山脉的心脏地带，带您领略迷人的山脉风光和历史遗址。**津瓦利水库** - 这是一座美丽的人造湖，湖水呈迷人的绿松石色，四周被郁郁葱葱的山脉环抱。水库的景色如画，是一个理想的休闲和拍照胜地。**阿纳努里要塞** - 这座 17 世纪的历史城堡曾是阿拉格维公爵的住所。要塞周围被防御墙和瞭望塔环绕，内部有几座保存完好的教堂，教堂上装饰着精美的石雕。这里是一个历史与自然相融合的地方，展现了中世纪建筑的魅力。**古达乌里** - 是一个著名的滑雪度假村，位于海拔 2,000 米的地方，坐落在大高加索山脉的南坡。古达乌里以其壮丽的山脉景色和丰富的冒险运动而闻名，是冬季滑雪爱好者的天堂，也是夏季徒步旅行的理想地点。**穿越贾尔维山口** - 海拔达到 2,385 米。山口提供了壮观的山脉景色，是连接格鲁吉亚和俄罗斯的古老贸易路线上的一个重要地点。**斯捷潘茨明达** - 这个小镇被雄伟的卡兹别吉山环绕，山脉的壮丽景色让人叹为观止。**4X4 吉普车冒险之旅** - 乘坐越野 4X4 车沿崎岖的山路前往格尔盖蒂三一教堂。这座 14 世纪的教堂位于海拔 2,170 米的山顶，背靠雄伟的卡兹别吉山，是一座完美的建筑杰作。教堂的石材建筑与山脉的壮丽景色相结合，创造出一种无与伦比的视觉震撼和灵性氛围。

## 第八天 格鲁吉亚 - 亚美尼亚哈赫帕特修道院 (283 公里，约 4 小时 30 分钟) - 塞凡湖 (137 公里，2 小时 30 分钟) - 埃里温 (68 公里，约 1 小时) 早午晚餐

从格鲁吉亚的萨达赫洛边境开始，进入亚美尼亚的北部。拥有郁郁葱葱的森林、巍峨的山脉和深邃的峡谷。联合国教科文组织世界遗产 - **桑哈因修道院和哈赫帕特修道院** - 建于公元 10 至 13 世纪，曾是一个宗教和学术的中心。院内保存着许多中世纪亚美尼亚建筑的珍贵遗迹，包括：**钟楼** - 哈赫帕特修道院的钟楼是中世纪亚美尼亚建筑的代表之一，建于 1245 年，是该地区最精美的钟楼之一。**餐厅** - 哈赫帕特修道院的餐厅建于 13 世纪，是修道院建筑群中最具特色的部分之一，至今保存完好。与桑哈因修道院一样，哈赫帕特修道院也曾设有著名的图书馆、抄写室和医学学校，这些文化和学术设施让修道院成为了当时知识和文化的传播中心。

## 第九天 埃里温 - 埃奇米阿津 (20 公里，约 25 分钟) - 加尔尼 (48 公里，约 1 小时) - 格赫哈德修道院 (9 公里，约 15 分钟) - 埃里温 早午晚餐

**埃奇米阿津镇** - 是亚美尼亚的古都，也是亚使徒教会的精神中心。这里是亚美尼亚基督教的发源地，拥有许多历史悠久的宗教遗址。**埃奇米阿津大教堂** - 是联合国教科文组织世界遗产之一，建于公元 301 年，由圣格雷戈里·伊路米内托尔创立，是世界上最古老的基督教教堂之一。埃奇米阿津大教堂不仅是宗教朝圣地，也是亚美尼亚历史和文化的重要象征。**加尔尼神庙** - 唯一保存下来的异教神庙，建于公元 77 年，由阿尔沙金王朝的特尔达特王为太阳神米尔特所建。神庙的建筑风格深受古希腊和罗马的影响，坐落在一片壮丽的自然景观中，拥有极高的历史和文化价值。**加尔尼皇宫和皇宫浴室遗址** - 展示了古代亚美尼亚王室的奢华生活和建筑风格，是了解亚美尼亚古代历史的重要场所。**查伦茨拱门** - 这里可以欣赏到雄伟的阿拉拉特山的美丽景色。



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## 第十天 埃里温 - 霍尔维拉普修道院 (44 公里约 1 小时) - 马泰纳达兰 (46 公里, 50 分钟) - 埃里温 早午晚餐

**阿拉拉特山谷** - 这座雄伟的山峰拥有两座洁白的高峰，是亚美尼亚文化和历史的象征。**霍尔维拉普修道院** - 一个重要的基督教朝圣地，位于一座小型地牢之上，传说圣格雷戈里·伊路米内托尔曾在此被囚禁 13 年。公元 301 年，圣格雷戈里被释放，这一历史性事件标志着亚美尼亚成为世界上第一个将基督教定为国教的国家，具有重要的历史意义。**阿尔塔沙特** - 这座城市约公元前 180 年由阿尔塔夏斯一世建立，是阿尔塔夏斯王朝的发源地。特殊之处在于它是由著名的迦太基将军哈尼拔设计的，哈尼拔在战败后逃亡到亚美尼亚。阿尔塔沙特因此成为几个由哈尼拔设计的古代城市之一。返回**埃里温** - 开始一场城市观光。包括**共和国广场**、**北大街**、**母亲亚美尼亚纪念碑**、**议会大厦**、**总统府**、**歌剧院**、**天鹅湖**以及**纪念 1915 年亚美尼亚大屠杀受害者的种族灭绝纪念馆和种族灭绝博物馆**。**马泰纳达兰** - 世界上最大的古代手稿馆之一，馆内收藏了约 17,000 部古代手稿，展示了亚美尼亚丰富的文学和历史遗产。**级联大楼** - 这是埃里温的现代艺术中心，整个区域展示了丰富的艺术作品，从大道到楼梯，一直向上展示着艺术作品。您还可以从级联大楼顶部欣赏到城市和阿拉拉特山的壮丽全景。

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## 12 DAYS 10 NIGHTS CROSSROADS HISTORICALLY CAUCASUS

### Azerbaijan + Georgian + Armenia

#### Day 1 Kuala Lumpur - Azerbaijan

(Mob)

Assemble at KLIA 1, check in and flight to Azerbaijan - Heydar Aliyev International Airport – Baku.

#### Day 2 Baku

(L/D)

Baku Old City Tour – Modern and Ancient Azerbaijan. Begin exploration with a panoramic view of **Baku Bay from Upland Park**, offering stunning cityscapes of the Caspian Sea. Next, we explore the heart of Baku's history – the Walled Old City, **Icherisheher** – a UNESCO-listed site, where past and present intertwine. **Shirvanshah's Palace** (15th century) – the former royal residence of the **Shirvanshah Dynasty**. **Maiden Tower** (12th century) – The most mysterious monument in Baku, with legends linked to Zoroastrian rituals and Silk Road traders. **Caravanserai** – once a rest stops for merchants on the Silk Road, now a charming courtyard. **Narrow cobblestone streets** with unique old-world charm. **Juma Mosque** (12th century) - the Old City is still inhabited, with over 1,300 families living within its walls, making it a "city within a city."

#### Day 3 Baku – Gobustan – Mud Volcanoes (80km 2h30m) – Absheron Peninsula (55km 1h30m) – Baku (13km 30m)

(B/L/D)

Excursion to **Gobustan** (UNESCO-listed site), home to over 6,000 ancient rock carvings, depicting prehistoric hunting scenes, rituals, and animals. Visit Azerbaijan's Famous **Mud Volcanoes** - Azerbaijan has nearly half of the world's mud volcanoes, rich in minerals, used for therapeutic and cosmetic purposes. Afternoon Visit to Absheron Peninsula. **Ateshgah Fire Temple** – a sacred Zoroastrian pilgrimage site. Pentagonal complex has an open courtyard with temple-altar in the center which was the place of pilgrimage for worshippers. **Yanar Dag** (Burning Mountain) – a natural gas fire that has been burning on the mountainside for centuries, inspiring the name "Land of Fire".

#### Day 4 Baku – Sheki Silk Road Town (15km 30m) - Baku

(B/L/D)

Drive to Sheki, stopping for breathtaking mountain views. We will take a panoramic tour and explore Sheki's Historical Treasures. **Sheki Khans' Palace** (1797) – a summer palace of Shaki Khans with stunning stained-glass windows. It was built in 1797 by Muhammed Hasan Khan. Along with its pool and plane trees, the summer residence is the only remaining structure from the larger complex inside the Sheki Khans' Fortress, which once included a winter palace, residences for the Khan's family and servants' quarters. It features decorative tiles, fountains, and several stained-glass windows. The exterior was decorated with dark blue, turquoise, and ochre tiles in geometric patterns and the murals were colored with tempera and were inspired by the works of Nizami Ganjavi. **Sheki Caravanserai** – an ancient Silk Road trading post.



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## Day 5 Cross into Georgia – Signaghi (112km 2h) – Bodbe Monastery (46km 1h) – Tbilisi (110km 2h) (B/L/D)

Cross the border at Lagodekhi, meet with Georgian guide. Tour to **Signaghi** – The Romantic "City of Love" with panoramic views of the Alazani Valley Perched on a hilltop at 790 meters above sea level. With cobblestone streets, pastel-colored houses, and traditional wooden balconies, this picturesque town is known for its timeless beauty and romantic atmosphere. The town is surrounded by a well-preserved 18th-century defensive wall, often referred to as the "Georgian Great Wall", offering breathtaking panoramic views of the Alazani Valley and the snow-capped Caucasus Mountains. Stroll through the narrow, atmospheric streets, lined with colorful wooden balconies, cozy cafes, and artisan shops. **Bodbe Monastery** – The Sacred Resting Place of St. Nino, who brought Christianity to Georgia. A 9th-century monastic complex and one of the most revered pilgrimage sites in Georgia. Visit **St. Nino's Spring**, believed to have healing properties, where many pilgrims come to seek blessings and spiritual renewal. Enjoy and exploring **Georgia's legendary wine culture** with Wine tasting at Kindzmarauli Corporation.

## Day 6 Tbilisi City Tour – A Blend of East and West (B/L/D)

**Tbilisi** - a city that harmoniously blends its **medieval, classical, and modern influences**. Visit to:

**Metekhi Church & Statue of King Vakhtang Gorgasali** – Located on a cliff overlooking the **Mtkvari River**, this church marks one of the **earliest inhabited areas of Tbilisi**.

**Narikala Fortress** – Take a **cable car ride from Rike Park** to this ancient stronghold that has **protected Tbilisi since the 4th century**. Enjoy **breathtaking views** of the cityscape.

**Abanotubani (Sulfur Baths District)** – Stroll through this **iconic district**, famous for its natural **hot sulfur springs**. These baths have been a **center of relaxation and healing for centuries**.

**Sioni Cathedral** – A historic **Georgian Orthodox Cathedral**, named after Mount Zion in Jerusalem. It once housed **St. Nino's Cross**, a sacred relic of Georgia's Christian heritage.

**Sharden Street** – A **charming, modern street** lined with cozy cafes, art galleries, and boutique shops.

**Bridge of Peace** – A **stunning glass-and-steel pedestrian bridge**, designed by Italian architect Michele De Lucchi in **2010**. The bridge connects Tbilisi's **historic old town with its modern districts**.

**Holy Trinity Cathedral (Sameba)** – One of the **largest Orthodox churches in the world**, this **architectural masterpiece** was completed in **2004** and serves as the **spiritual heart of Georgia's Orthodox faith**.

**Drive along Rustaveli Avenue**, the main boulevard of Tbilisi, home to the **Parliament of Georgia, Opera House, and Freedom Square**.

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## Day 7 Tbilisi – Ananuri (65km 1h30m) – Jinali Reservoir (9km 15m) – Gudauri (65km 1h30m) – Kazbegi Gergeti Church (38km 1h) - Tbilisi (B/L/D)

Explore Georgia's Most Breathtaking Landscapes Along the **Historic Georgian Military Road**, a legendary route that winds through the heart of the **Greater Caucasus Mountains**. Our first stop is the **picturesque Jinali Reservoir**, a stunning man-made turquoise lake nestled among lush mountains. **17th-century Ananuri Fortress**, a historical castle complex that once served as the residence of the **Dukes of Aragvi**. Surrounded by defensive walls and watchtowers, the complex includes **beautifully preserved churches** adorned with intricate stone carvings. **Gudauri**, a renowned **ski resort** situated at **2,000 meters above sea level**. Located on the **southern slopes of the Greater Caucasus**, famous for its **breathtaking mountain scenery** and **adventure sports**. Further north, we cross the scenic **Jvari Pass**, reaching an altitude of **2,385 meters**. The pass offers **dramatic mountain views** and is a key point along the **ancient trade route** connecting Georgia with Russia. Arriving in **Stepantsminda (Kazbegi)**, we find ourselves in one of the **most stunning natural settings in Georgia**. The small town is framed by the **majestic Mount Kazbek (5,033 meters)**, one of the highest peaks in the Caucasus. **4X4 Jeep Adventure** – we take **off-road 4X4 vehicles** up a rugged mountain path to reach the **Gergeti Holy Trinity Church**. Perched at an elevation of **2,170 meters**, **Gergeti Holy Trinity Church** is an architectural masterpiece from the **14th century**. Set against the stunning backdrop of **Mount Kazbek**, this remote monastery offers **unparalleled views and a spiritual atmosphere**. The combination of **medieval stone architecture and dramatic mountain scenery** creates a truly **breathtaking experience**.

## Day 8 Georgia – Armenia Haghpat UNESCO Monastery(283km 4h30m) – Sevanavank (137km 2h30m) – Yerevan (68km 1h) (B/L/D)

Transfer to Georgian-Armenian border Sadakhlo. Northern Armenia, a magical region of lush forests, towering mountains, and deep canyons. This region is famous for some of the most stunning examples of medieval Armenian architecture, including the **UNESCO World Heritage**-listed monasteries of **Sanahin** and **Haghpat**. **Haghpat Monastery**, located just to the north-east of Sanahin, is equally captivating and bears striking architectural similarities to its sister complex. Established between the X and XIII centuries, Haghpat flourished as both a religious center and a place of learning. It is home to one of the finest examples of medieval Armenian bell towers, built in 1245, and the **refectory** (XIII century) which remains a remarkable feature of the monastery complex. As at Sanahin, Haghpat also housed a renowned library, scriptorium, and medical school. Continue journey to **Lake Sevan**, one of the largest high-altitude freshwater lakes, where you'll visit **Sevanavank Monastery** on the peninsula, offering sweeping views over the lake.





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## Day 9 Yerevan – Etchmiadzin (20km 25m) – Garni (48km 1h) – Geghard(9km 15m) - Yerevan

(B/L/D)

**Etchmiadzin town**, the ancient capital of Armenia and the spiritual center of the Armenian Apostolic Church. Visit the **Etchmiadzin Cathedral**, a **UNESCO World Heritage site**, founded in 301 A.D by St. Gregory the Illuminator and thus being one of the ancient churches in the Christian world. Head to **Garni Temple**, the only remaining pagan temple in Armenia, devoted to the God of Sun – Myrth, in Garni, built in 77 AD by King Trdat (Arshakid Dynasty). Visit to the ruins of **Royal Palace** and **Royal bath-house** next to Garni temple. On the way enjoy a photo stop at the **Charentc Arc** with a nice view on Ararat Mountain.

## Day 10 Yerevan – Khor Virap(44km 1h) – Matenadaran (46km 50m) - Yerevan

(B/L/D)

**Ararat valley**, marvel the gorgeous biblical Mount Ararat shining with its two majestic white peaks. **Khor Virap Church**, an important Christian pilgrimage site located atop a small dungeon where St. Gregory the Illuminator was imprisoned for 13 years. St. Gregory's release in **301 AD** marked a pivotal moment in history, as Armenia became the first nation in the world to **adopt Christianity as its state religion**. **Artashat**, established around 180 B.C. by King Artashes I, the founder of the Artashesid dynasty. Notably, Artashat is one of the few ancient towns designed by the special project by the renowned Carthaginian general Hannibal, who sought refuge in Armenia after his defeat in a war against Rome. Return to Yerevan with a guided city tour, including **City center, Republic Square, Northern Avenue, the Mother Armenia Monument, Parliament, President's Palace, Opera House, Swan Lake** and **Genocide Memorial**, dedicated to the Victims of 1915 and the Genocide Museum. Visit **Matenadaran**, home to one of the world's largest collections of 17,000 ancient manuscripts. Explore **Cascade Complex**, the hub of contemporary art in Yerevan with art pieces displayed throughout the whole area: the boulevard and up the stairs. From top of Cascade the marvelous panoramic view on the city and Mountain Ararat is open. Cascade is home to Cafesjian modern art museum.

## Day 11 Yerevan – Kuala Lumpur
